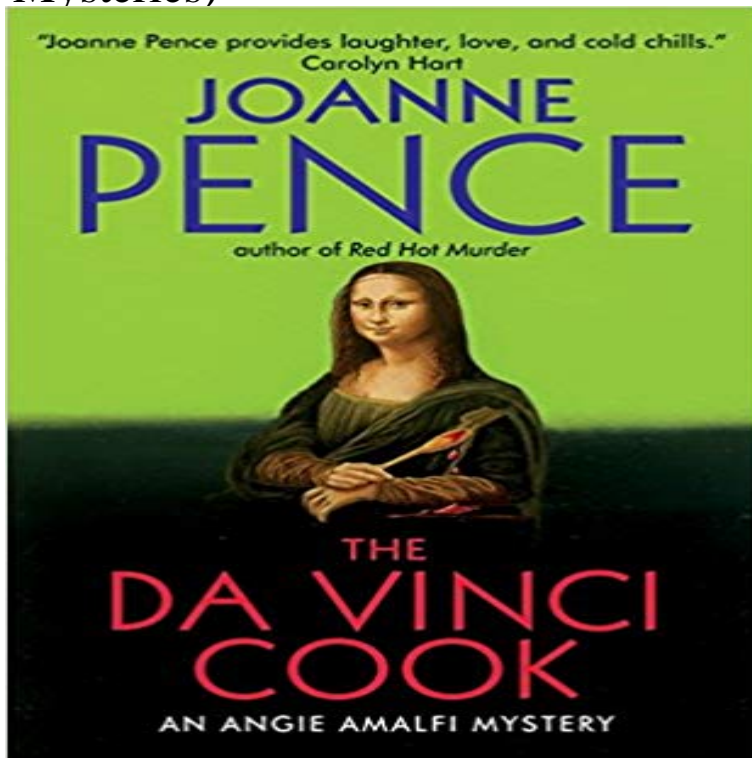


The Da Vinci Cook: An Angie Amalfi Mystery (Angie Amalfi Mysteries)
