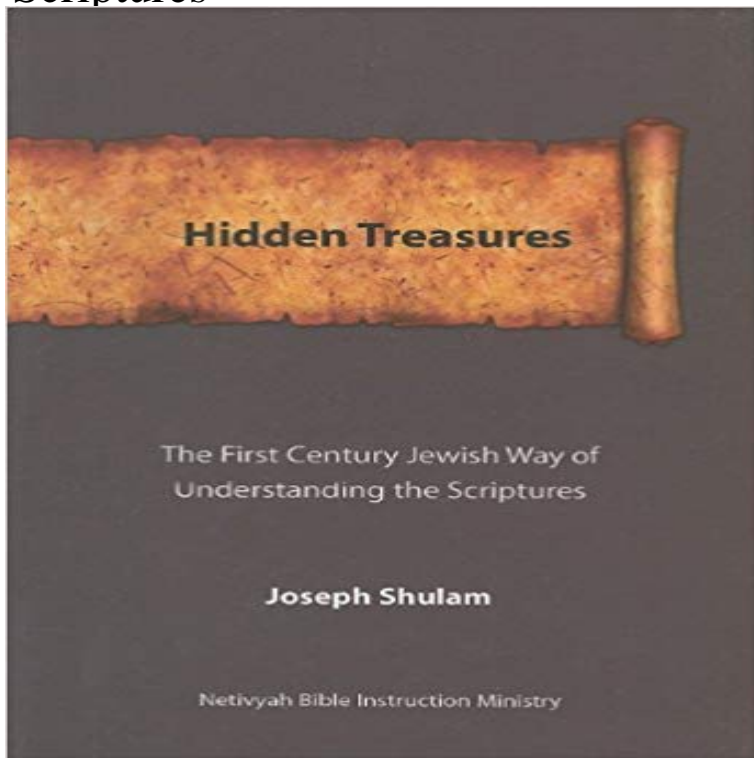


# Hidden Treasures: The First Century Jewish Way of Understanding the Scriptures
