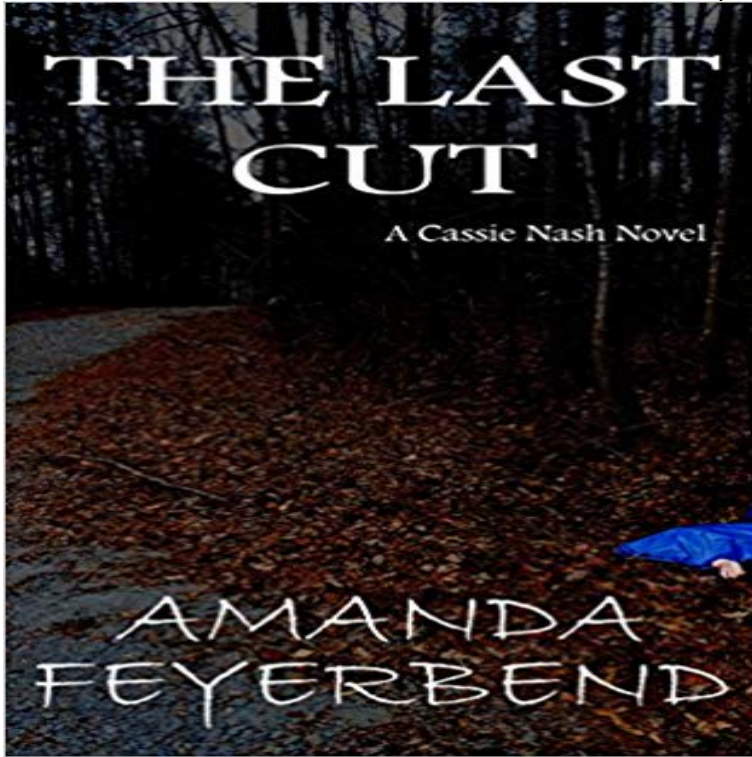


The Last Cut: A Cassie Nash Novel (Pruitt County Mysteries Book 3)
