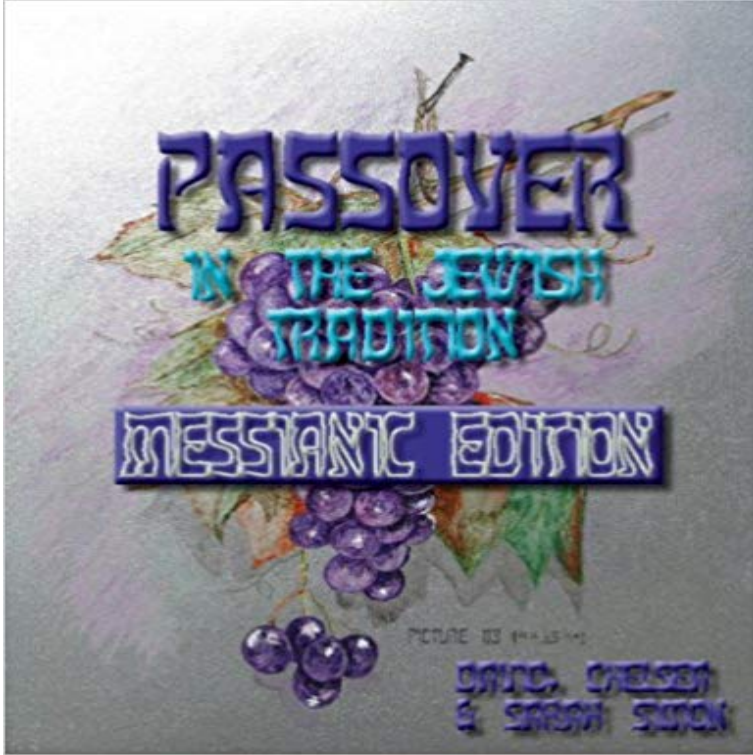


Passover in the Jewish Tradition: Messianic Edition
