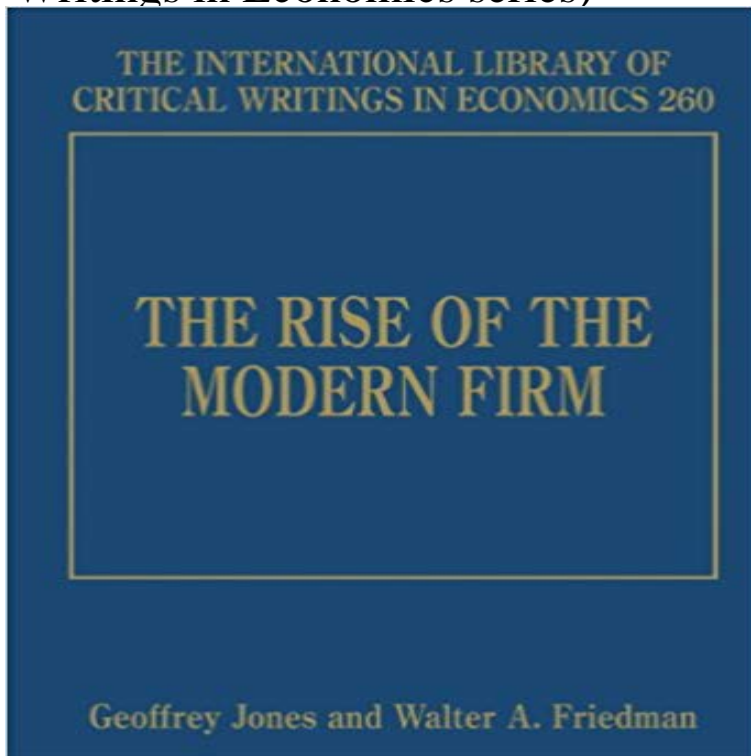


The Rise of the Modern Firm (The International Library of Critical Writings in Economics series)
