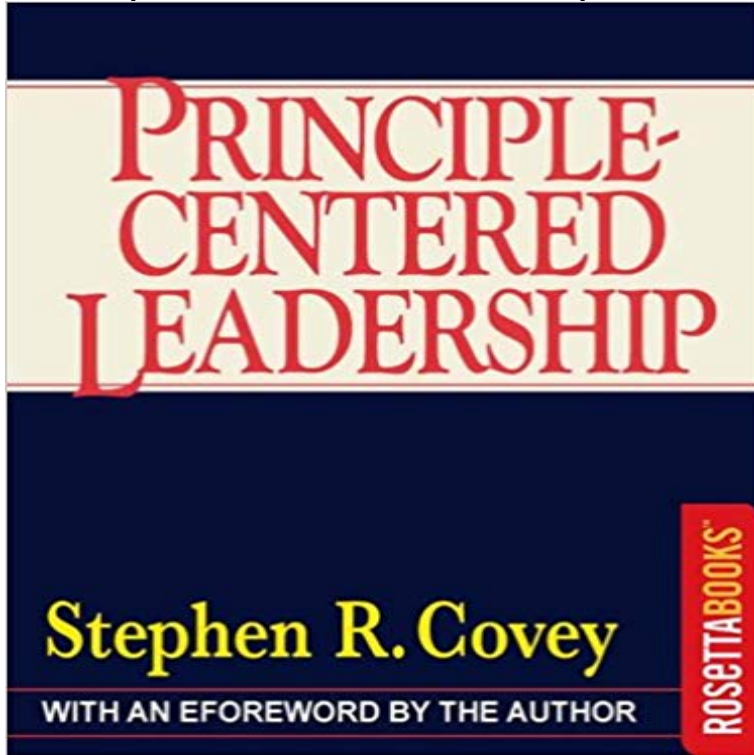


Principle-Centered Leadership
