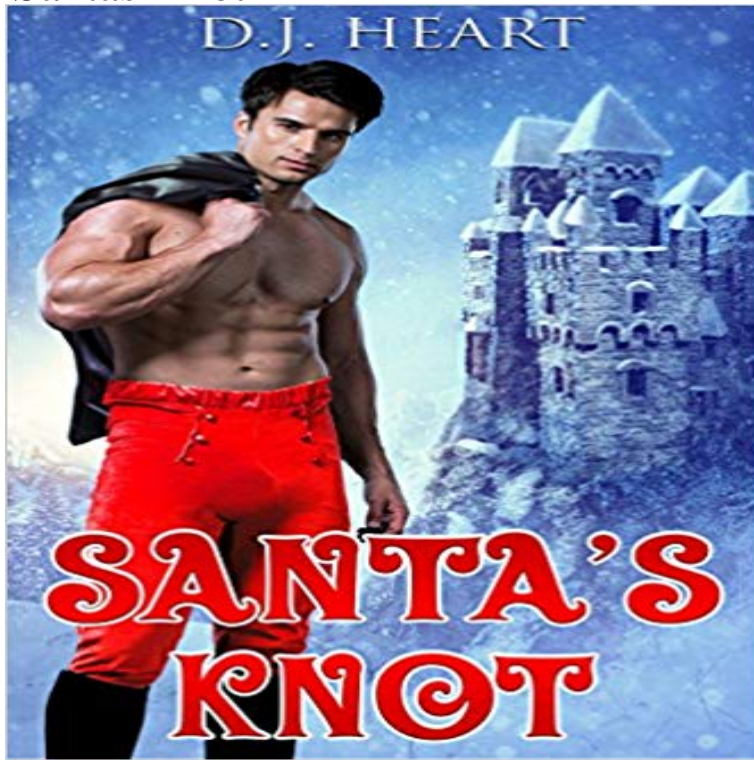


Santas Knot
