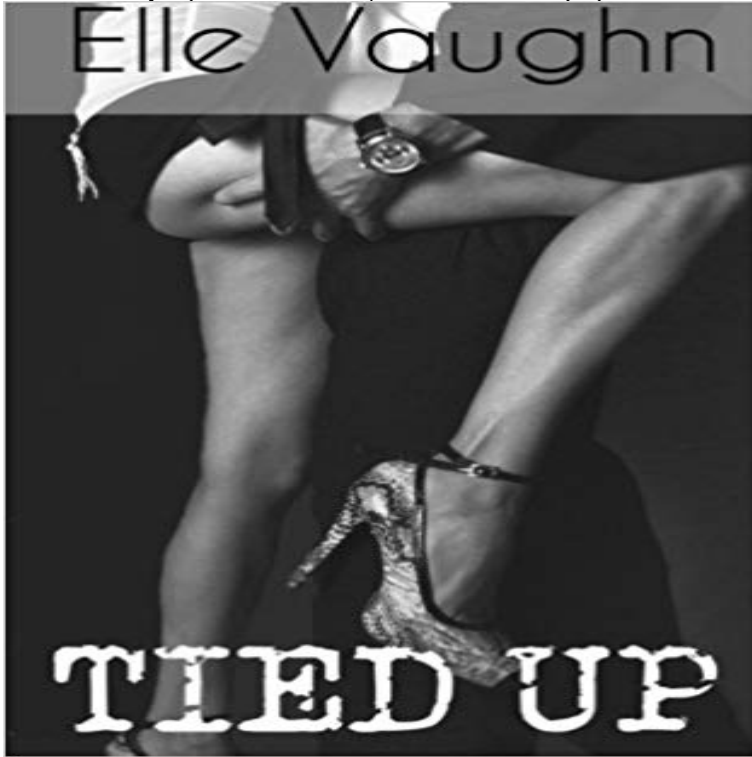


Tied Up (Galloway Brothers) (Volume 1)
