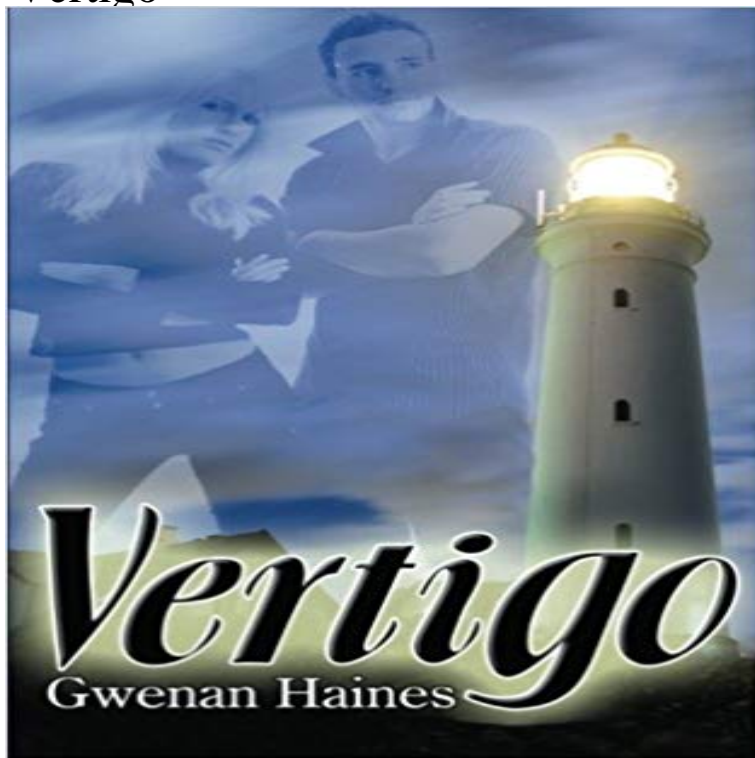


Vertigo
